


Welcome to Barcelona Obertura Season 23-24

We are proud to present a new edition of Barcelona Obertura, Classical & Lyrical season, a joint initiative of the Liceu Opera, the Palau de la Música Catalana and L'Auditori promoting Barcelona as one of the cities where classical music matters most.

With the enormous success of the first Barcelona Obertura Spring Festival in March 2019, our town now has a festival devoted to the most renowned and celebrated classical music artists while showcasing the talent of our local musicians.

In addition to promoting the city of Barcelona internationally through classical music, Barcelona Obertura is committed to bringing music to residents and visitors alike. This year marks the 5th edition of the free festival Ciutat de Clàssica, held in parallel to the Obertura Spring Festival, in which young talent from the city bring music to audiences in such unexpected places as museums, art galleries, libraries, neighbourhood civic centres or even historic buildings.

June sees the acclaimed free concert Clàssica a la Platja. The Liceu Opera Orchestra and the Barcelona Symphony Orchestra (OBC), together with the choirs of the Palau, perform a symphonic concert on the beach with a stage built on the sand in front of more than 40.000 people with the Mediterranean Sea as a background.

This collaboration between different institutions shows the capacity of the cultural institutions in Barcelona and their enormous potential.

I want to thank all three institutions for their commitment. Recognise the work done by their conductors and teams, and all our partners involved. Barcelona Obertura shows our determination to establish our city among the most attractive cultural capitals in the south of Europe.


Spring Festival
